The Gestures That Matter

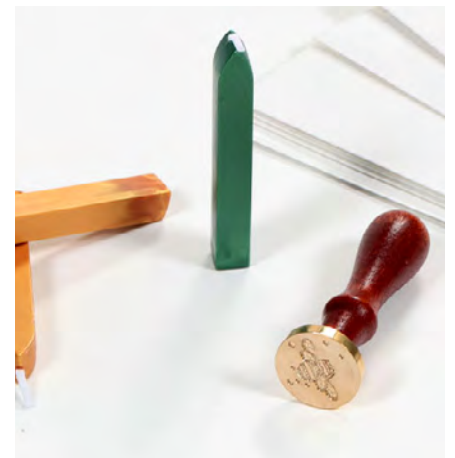
Some attentions stand the test of time.

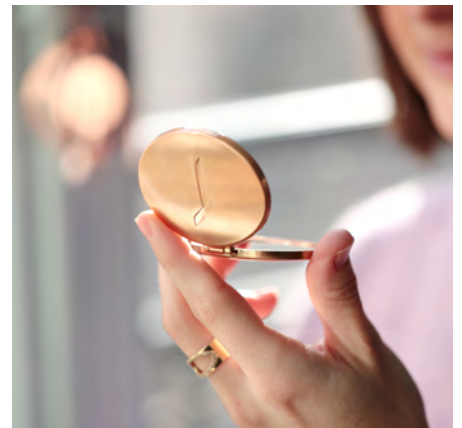
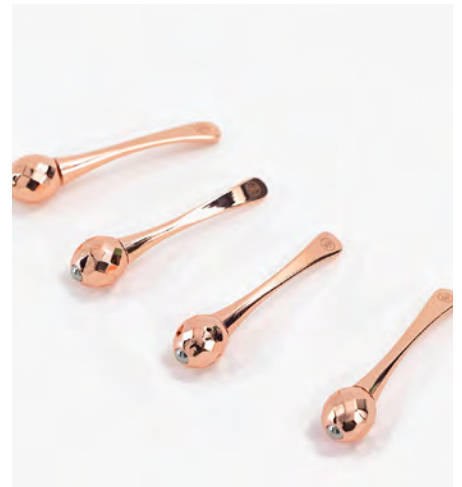


For her

Objects That Stand the Test of Time

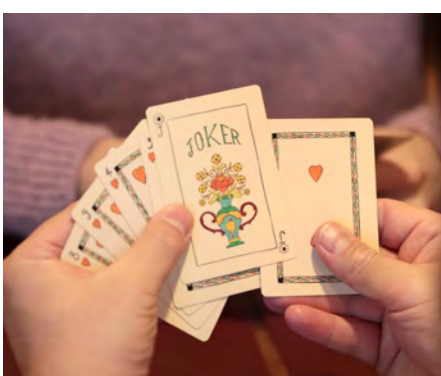
Some objects take on a special meaning over the years. Not only for what they are, but for the memories they gather.

Because some things do more than endure time. They tell it.

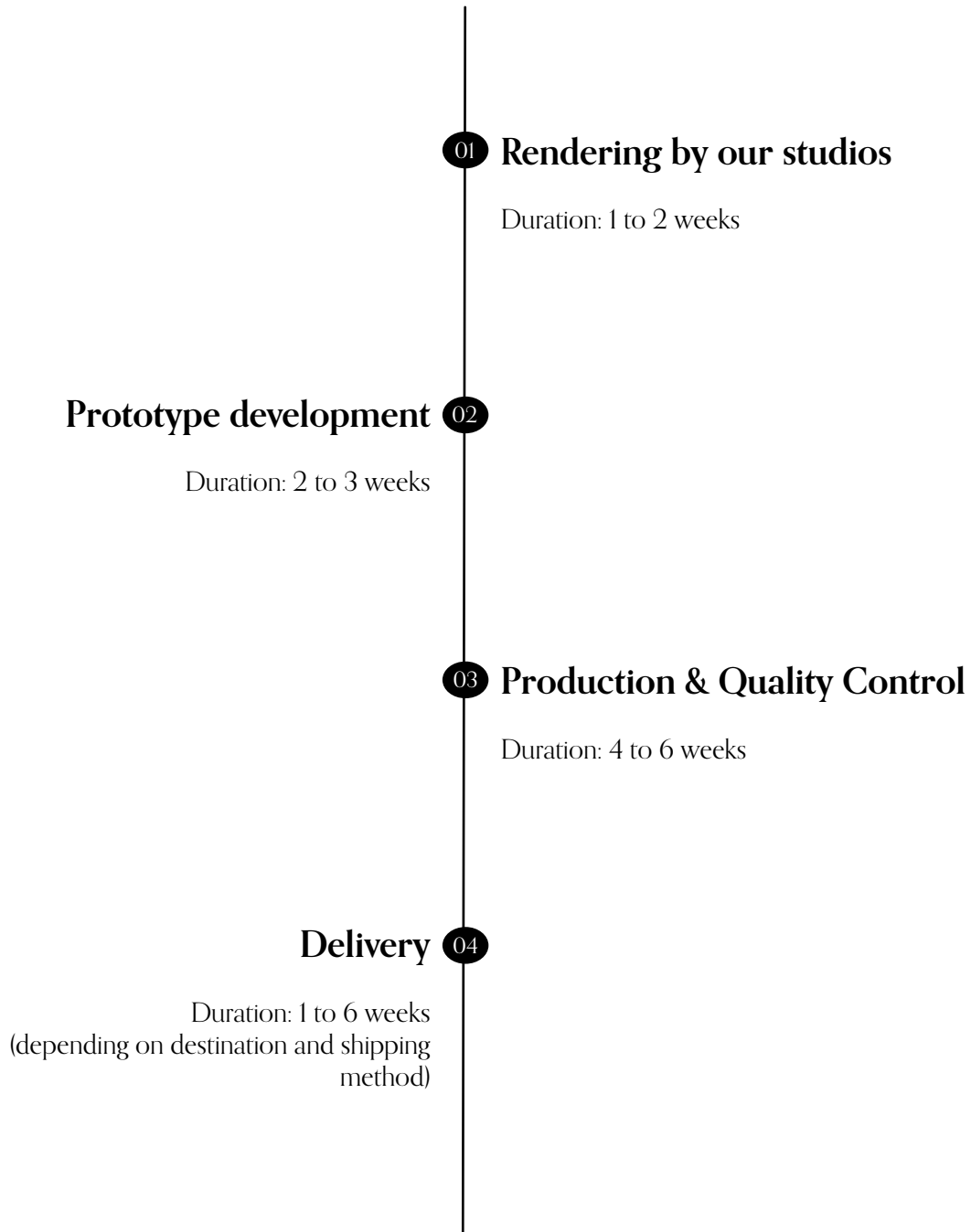
